## **Brief Explanation:**

In the state of California, an English Learner (EL) qualifies to be reclassified as Fluent English Proficient (RFEP) when he/she is able to attain acceptable standards in four specified areas.

For the 2014-2015 school year, three of the four Reclassification Criteria will remain the same as they have been for many years. They are:

- 1. California English Language Development Test (CELDT): Scores from the current school year to reflect an Overall Proficiency Level (OPL) of Advanced or Early Advanced with at least three subtests of CELDT at Advanced or Early Advanced, and a fourth subtest at Advanced, Early Advanced, or Intermediate.
- 2. Teacher Judgment: The student's elementary classroom teacher or secondary English teacher believes the student is able to be successful in core subject areas in a regular program designed for native and fluent speakers of English.
- 3. Parent/Guardian Consultation: Parents/Guardians are given an opportunity to consult with staff regarding the reclassification process and programs to further increase prospects for their child's academic achievement.

The fourth criterion for Reclassification requires a comparison of student performance on an objective assessment of basic skills in English Language Arts. The fourth criterion has long been CST-ELA scores, but because CST-ELA is no longer in use, the fourth criterion will now be different.

Details of the new fourth criterion for Reclassification for each level are provided in the table below.
