**Action Requested:** All high schools with established UC 'a-g' Course Lists must complete and return the attached 2017–18 UC 'a-g' Course List update documents (Attachments 2 and 3) to Karen Wilson in the Office of Secondary Schools by **May 5, 2017**

**Brief Explanation:**

The University of California requires all high schools and/or districts to update their UC 'a-g' Course Lists annually to accurately reflect the 'a-g' courses each school will offer in the upcoming school year. As in previous years, high schools' 'a-g' course lists will be updated centrally through a district submission, based on information they provide in the 2017–18 UC 'a-g' Course List update documents attached to this circular.

To that end, Principals are asked to complete and return the following to Karen Wilson, Office of Secondary Schools, Room 2005, Eugene Brucker Education Center, by **Friday, May 5, 2017** via school mail:

**1. Principal UC 'a-g' Course List Certification Form (Attachment 2)**

A signed Principal Certification Form must accompany the school's updated 2017–18 UC 'a-g' course worksheets. Principals are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of the course information reported on their school's published UC 'a-g' Course List each year; by signing this certification form, they acknowledge they have reviewed the updated course worksheets and agree that this information should be submitted as their school's official 2017–18 UC 'a-g' Course List.

**2. UC 'a-g' Course Worksheets (Attachment 3)**

The UC 'a-g' Course Worksheets include one for each 'a-g' subject area, plus a separate worksheet for Advanced Placement (AP) courses. The course choices they show are the ones schools made for school's 2016–17 'a-g' course lists. These choices must be updated for the 2017–18 school year by removing courses that will no longer be available and adding new 'a-g' courses that are planned, see Attachment 1 for specific instructions. Because UC 'a-g' Course Lists are year-specific records of the course opportunities

available to students at your school, the updated worksheets should include only those 'a-g' courses that are in your site's 2017–18 master schedule.

Before updating the worksheets, please read **Attachment 1- 2017–2018 UC 'a-g' Course List Updates and Instructions** in its entirety, as it contains important information about new courses, course title updates, potential new course offerings, and course sequencing.

**Important Deadlines:**

**May 5, 2017** - Deadline for schools to submit their updated 2017-18 'a-g' Course List worksheets to Karen Wilson via School mail (Attachment 2 and Attachment 3).

**September 5, 2017** - Deadline for schools to have AP Audit approval for all new and renewed AP courses they will be offering to ensure they get on the school's 2017-18 UC 'a-g' Course List. **September 15, 2017** - Deadline for all 2017-18 UC 'a-g' Course List changes to be entered into the UC system.

Updates made to schools' UC 'a-g' Course Lists do not affect schools' NCAA Course Lists, which are maintained separately by the Office of Secondary Schools. ## 2017 - 2018 UC 'A-G' COURSE LIST GENERAL COURSE UPDATES & INSTRUCTIONS

This document provides general information about the course list update process, important 2017 - 2018 course updates and/or changes, as well as instructions for completing the course worksheets in Attachment 3. All district courses currently approved to meet UC 'a-g' subject requirements in 2017–18 are listed on the subject worksheets in Attachment 3. No other courses are 'a-g' approved at this time.

### LIMITATIONS

Certain courses are NOT eligible to be included on a high school's 'a-g' list due to UC restrictions. These include: college courses, Independent World Language School (IWLS) courses, and courses not offered at the high-school level.

Certain types of courses require permission for a school to offer them and add them to their 'a-g' list. These include:

#### **Career Technical Education (CTE) Courses**

The College, Career, and Technical Education (CCTE) Department must approve all CTE courses that a school wants to add to its 2017–18 'a-g' list. CTE courses can be identified on the worksheets by the “(CTE)” tag next to the course title. Confirmation of CCTE approval (in the form of an email) is required. #### **Site-Adopted Courses**

Site-adopted courses and the sites approved to offer them are clearly identified on the subject-area worksheets. These courses are not available to other schools. A non-approved site wanting to offer a site-adopted course must obtain Board approval via the Interdivisional Curriculum Committee (ICC) to do so. Information about the ICC process can be found on the Office of Secondary Schools' web page on the district web site.

#### **Advanced Placement (AP) Courses**

All school-site AP courses must be authorized or reauthorized by the College Board's AP Course Audit in order to be included on a school's UC a-g' list each year. To ensure placement on schools' 2017–18 'a-g' lists, all AP courses must be Audit approved no later than September 5, 2017. New AP courses are required to provide an approved Audit syllabus number to be put on a school's list. Please see Administrative Circular: AP Audit Authorization of Advanced Placement Courses for 2017-2018. Questions concerning AP Course Audit need to be directed to R. #### **AVID Courses**

Only schools listed on the district's annual AVID membership contract are authorized to offer AVID courses and use the AVID logo. - All four courses—AVID 9, AVID 10, AVID 11, and AVID 12—are approved as UC 'g' electives and are listed on the worksheets.

**VAPA Music Course Sequences**

The VAPA Department has been working to update its music course sequences to provide students with four years of unduplicated study in a number of different music areas, as described below. This will result in the following changes for 2017 – 2018.

**MUSIC PILOT COURSES:**

Music a-g approved courses being piloted in the 2016-2017 school year are noted on the worksheets. If the pilot is approved by ICC, the expectation is that they will be opened up to all schools in 2017 - 2018.

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR UPDATING WORKSHEETS**

Your UC 'a-g' course list is a year-specific record of the college-preparatory courses taught at your school that must be updated annually. Please update them for the 2017 - 2018 school year as described below:

**Process:**

1. All worksheets should be printed-out and revised using a **RED** or **BLUE** pen. The school's name should appear at the top of each worksheet.
2. All changes must be noted in the left-hand margin next to the course number and title.
3. Do not add or delete any 'x's' in the grids.
4. Print out the worksheets in Attachment 3 and review them for accuracy. They should reflect all 'a-g' courses being taught at your site this year and match the information on your school's published UC 'a-g' Course List, which can be accessed at <http://www.ucop.edu/agguide/>. Record any discrepancies you find at the bottom of the worksheet and correct the information for your site's 2017-18 UC 'a-g' list.
5. Update all worksheets to reflect the courses your school will offer in 2017–18:

**A-G Subject Worksheets:**

- A) No Change:** If no course changes are needed on a worksheet page, write “*No Change*” or “*NC*” at the top of the page and circle it.
- B) Changes:** Record all course changes you want to effect in the left-hand margin of the worksheet next to the course number and title as follows:
- To **ADD (A)** a course to your 2017 - 2018 'a-g' list, circle the course number and course title on the worksheet and write 'A' in the margin next to it.

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- To **DELETE (D)** and remove a course that will no longer be taught at your site, put a line through the course number and title, and write 'D' in the margin next to it.

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**AP Worksheets:**

- To **REAUTHORIZE (R)**: For AP courses that you plan to reauthorize for the 2017-18 school year, put an 'R' in the left-hand margin next to the course number and title.
  - To **DELETE (D)**: If you are NOT offering in 2017-18 an AP course that you have previously offered, put a 'D' in the left-hand margin next to the course number and title.
  - For **NEW AP course(s) (N)** you plan to offer in 2017–18, put an 'N' next to the course number and title. New AP courses include any AP course that was not taught at your site this year and any AP course assigned to a teacher who has not previously taught it.
6. Principals will review the changes, sign and attach the Principal Certification Form, and mail completed documents to Karen Wilson by **May 5, 2017**.
