

TIME LIMITS based on Bylaws of the Board of Education Readopted by the Board of Education December 11, 2007	
Public Testimony	Public Testimony shall be limited to a maximum of 20 (twenty) minutes per consent and/or action item allowing for a maximum of 10 (ten) minutes per opposing viewpoint, and with a maximum of three (3) minutes per speaker unless such time limit is waived by the Board President. The President shall announce the amount of time allocated for public testimony on agenda items prior to hearing the public testimony.
Testimony on Non-Agenda Items	Testimony on non-agenda items shall be limited to a maximum of 15 (fifteen) minutes per item with a maximum of three (3) minutes per speaker unless such time limit is waived by the Board President.
Interruption of Public Testimony	Any public testimony may be interrupted at any time on motion of any one member of the Board or by the Superintendent. If interrupted, the Board then shall decide whether it should continue to hear the speaker in public meeting, whether it should hear the speaker in private closed session, or whether it should refuse to continue hearing the speaker at all.
Board Members	Please note that although no mention is made of time limits for board members, it now includes them and the limit is the same as for public speakers . Time limits for board members was implemented after adoption of the bylaws on December 11, 2007.
