Why Redistrict?

- •Every 10 years after the Decennial Census, San Diego Unified School District must consider redrawing their district boundaries to reflect the changes in population — Data delayed this year
- •All redistricting must use the 2020 Census PL94-171 data and associated Census geography
- •Trustee subdistrict boundaries are separate from school attendance boundaries.



Voting Rights Act of 1965

Voting Rights Act of 1965 – to remedy the inequality of opportunity provided to racial and ethnic minorities to participate in elections



Redistricting Criteria

- Equal Population All subdistricts should have equal population - as equal as possible
- ☐ The Maximum Deviation should not be more than 10%
 - Maximum Deviation is the difference between the most populated subdistrict and the least populated subdistrict.
- Subdistricts should be compact and contiguous
- Minorities should be fairly represented
- Communities of Interests

Redistricting Engagement Committee

- Reviewed current plan (status quo) plus 7 new plans
- ☐ Bringing forward to the board 3 plans for consideration:

Status Quo

- No change in boundaries
- Results in 3 ethnic plurality subdistricts
- Pop. Deviation is 9.33%

Plan E

- Creates 4 ethnic plurality subdistricts
- Pop. Deviation is 3.73%

Plan E-1

- Creates 4 ethnic
 plurality subdistricts
 with more balance in
 schools and clusters
- Pop. Deviation is 3.81%














Status Quo -Current Districts – Max Dev (9.33%)
