At the conclusion of the closed session, the Board returns to open session, and announces in writing actions taken on any reportable matters. The written report forms are thereafter maintained in the Board Services Office. Items for closed session are listed on an agenda which is posted in advance in the glass window area at the entrance to the Auditorium. Following the completion of this closed session process, the Board reconvenes in its regular open session meeting which takes place in the Auditorium as announced on the open session agenda.
