Brief Explanation:

In accordance with Education Code 60119, each school district's governing board must hold a public hearing no later than the eighth week of the school year to determine, through a resolution, whether each pupil in the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, in the following subjects: mathematics, science, history/social science, and English language arts. The governing board must also determine whether each student enrolled in a foreign language or health course has been provided sufficient textbooks or instructional materials. According to Williams Legislation, sufficient textbooks or instructional materials means each pupil, including English learners, must have a district-adopted textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home. Access to two sets of instructional materials is not required.

To ensure your school is sufficient and meets the requirements of the law, it is necessary for you to complete the attached *Principal Verification Statement-Instructional Materials Sufficiency* – *Gr. 6-8* (Att. B) by September 20, 2013 and email instmatlmail@sandi.net or fax (619) 542-5796 a signed copy to the Instructional Materials Office (IMO). *Note: Schools subject to a Williams team audit by the San Diego County Office of Education are not required to participate in this process. Compliance will be determined by the Williams team visit.*

This deadline is critical to meeting the requirements of Education Code 60119 and receiving State instructional materials funding.

Below is an outline of this process to assist you.

- Complete the *Instructional Materials Sufficiency Survey* (Att. A) by September 13, 2013.
- Base your data on inventory of core instructional materials using Destiny Textbook Manager and Powerschool student enrollment in core courses for a specific day, no later than September 13, 2013, with the understanding that course enrollments will change and sufficiency of instructional materials will be maintained as needed.

If the results of the Instructional Materials Survey indicate sufficiency at your site:

- Complete the *Principal Verification Statement-Instructional Materials Sufficiency Gr. 6-8* (Att. B) by confirming, signing, and dating the form.

If the results of the Instructional Materials Survey indicate insufficiencies at your site:

It may also be necessary to order adequate instructional materials by contacting Julio Gomez at jgomez1@sandi.net or (858) 522-5867.
- Receive and distribute the additional materials to students.
- Complete the *Principal Verification Statement-Instructional Materials Sufficiency Gr. 6-8* (Att. B) by confirming, signing, and dating the form.
