San Diego Unified has a robust small business program. We are exceedingly proud to report that to date, more than \$1.3 billion have been spent with XBEs.

XBE is a non-specific term encompassing a broad range of diverse business ownership. Formerly "EBE," for Emerging Business Enterprise, XBE is an umbrella term that includes small business and minority, woman, and disabled veteranowned business enterprises, and similar designations.

Capital improvement bond funds Propositions S and Z, and Measures YY and U provide \$11.6 billion to design and construct clean, safe, environmentally friendly facilities that encourage successful teaching and learning at schools throughout the district.

THE PROJECT ARCHIVE IS BACK!

San Diego Unified has resurrected its past project archive on a new platform! Contractors can once again access past project bid information to conduct research and due diligence to support future bidding decisions. Archived documents include bid ads, site walk sign-in sheets, and bid tabulations.

WHY YOU WANT THIS INFORMATION:

- ✓ Bid ads provide an overview of the scope of work (does this work pertain to you?)
- Site walk sign-ins provide a list of interested bidders (Primes you work with/want to know and competitors, or lack thereof) and their contact information (you can now call/email them!)
- won the project (subs, now you know who to contact!) and their listed subcontractors (if you know your competition, figure out whether or not you can compete in future similar bids)

DIVERSE BUSINESS PARTICIPATION REPORT*

The business outreach team sets annual XBE participation goals that reflect the local market. Participation is tracked and provided to the Independent Citizens Oversight Committee and Board of Education. The table below shows the goals for and participation of XBEs in district projects.

DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS NEWS

On Jan. 1, 2023, the Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) verification process, previously conducted by the Veteran Administration's Center for Verification and Evaluation (CVE), transferred to the Small Business Administration (SBA). Here are some things you need to know to be able to find and vet SDVOSB verification status:

- SDVOSB verifications that were to expire in 2023 have been granted a one-year extension by SBA.
- San Diego Unified will accept expired verification letters for one year beyond any 2023 expiration dates.
- Oueries to find SDVOSBs and vet verification status can be conducted at SBA's portal: veterans.certify.sba.gov
- · For anyone previously using the System for Award Management (SAM), note that SAM will not accurately reflect SDVOSB status, so only confirm SDVOSB status via the new SBA portal.

Please note that this information pertains only to federal SDVOSB-verified companies. The state of California DVBE (Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise) Program is separate from the federal program. DVBE status is still confirmed here: https:// caleprocure.ca.gov/pages/ PublicSearch/supplier-search. aspx

BE A BETTER BIDDER

All questions regarding any solicitations must be submitted through PlanetBids during the noted Request for Information (RFI) period. This includes questions about formatting, required document completion, scope of work clarification/questions, etc.

Inquiries submitted outside the RFI period cannot be answered until after evaluations are complete and the Board of Education has approved the agreement(s) with the recommended firms.


